

ONSTAGE APPLICATION: LINK UP ROCKS! 2026–2027

All classrooms participating in Link Up with the Seattle Symphony are invited to audition to play ONSTAGE with the orchestra! We will select 2-3 classes per concert to perform the Link Up repertoire from the stage, rather than from their seats, at the final concerts. Students performing onstage will also receive free Link Up t-shirts to wear during the concert.

Application is available to teachers upon registration.

RULES FOR AUDITIONING

1. Because this Google form has File Upload questions, respondents will be required to sign in.
2. Schools are *recommended* to submit a video recording of students performing one vocal piece and one recorder piece from any of the Link Up: The Orchestra Rocks repertoire list.
 - You may upload a video to the online application or submit a YouTube link
 - If submitting via YouTube, please make sure your video is marked “unlisted” and NOT “private.”
3. Submissions are due by **Sunday, January 31, 2027, by 11:59pm.**
4. Students do not need to memorize the repertoire; there will be several monitors onstage with the music projected.
5. Students do not need to be able to play and sing the entire repertoire at the concert for consideration. Schools will be selected based on level of engagement, enthusiasm, and ability to demonstrate good concert etiquette while onstage.
6. If selected, you will be asked to select between 20-40 students to be onstage. We leave this to teachers to determine which students would be the best fit for this experience.
7. If selected, your school will need to arrive at Benaroya Hall 30 minutes prior to your scheduled concert.
8. The students who are selected for the onstage experience will need permission from their families to be photographed by the Seattle Symphony for marketing, PR, education and development purposes. These forms will be sent to you from the Seattle Symphony.
9. You will be notified about final Link Up onstage selections by Friday, February 12, 2027.
